Program November 14

The Saturday, November 14, 2009 regular meeting of the Cradle of Texas Chapter TXSSAR will be held at the Red Snapper Restaurant in Surfside, Texas at 11:30 am. The principal speaker will be Dr. Tom Pruett, retired optometrist from Lake Jackson will present a program about the health services for the indigent that he is involved in the Brazosport area and Guerro, Mexico.

Tom was born October 18, 1931 in Pecos, Texas, the son of Thomas Benton Pruett, Sr. and Bessie Mae Sewell. He graduated from Pecos High School in 1948 and

attended Schreiner Institute from 1948-1950. He was awarded the Distinguished Alumni Award from that institution in 2005. He attended Texas Tech University from 1950-52 and then transferred to the University of Houston in 1952. He attended there until 1955 receiving his BS and Doctor of Optometry degree. He was an honor graduate of the College of Optometry.

After moving to Lake Jackson in 1956 he married Carolyn Gray Pessarra in 1960. They have two children, Tamara Tomlyn and Thomas Lloyd. In addition they have five grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Tom's journeys to Mexico began in 1980 when he founded the Guerro project and since that time has made at least two trips yearly. He has also made two trips to Belize.

His awards include: Brazosport Chamber of Commerce Outstanding Man in 1986, American Public Health Association Vision Care Distinguished Achievement Award in 1987, Rotary International Above Self Award in 1991, and Brazoport Rotary Club Rotarion of the Year Award 1992.

Since his retirement in 2000 he has been volunteering in Mexico. His latest achievement has been the establishment of the Dream Center in Clute.
