

Patriot Moses Gee

Patriot Moses Gee was born about 1760 in Dutchess County, NY, located in the Hudson Valley. In the Revolutionary War, Moses fought in the New York Line, 5th Regiment and, in 1780 at age 20. He was appointed as a corporal.

We know he later lived in Allegany County, Western New York, not far from Corning in Steuben County, NY.

With his wife, he later moved to OH to claim his bounty land warrant. It was there that he died at the age of 81.

One of his sons, Lucius, did not move to OH with his parents. Instead, he married a girl from Steuben County, NY and they made their way to CO. A generation later, Charles' (Dr. Charles Bernard's) mother was born in La Junta, CO.
