You're not just writing, you are etching your thoughts deep into history. The ink soaking deep into the fiber of the hand pressed paper. What will you write?



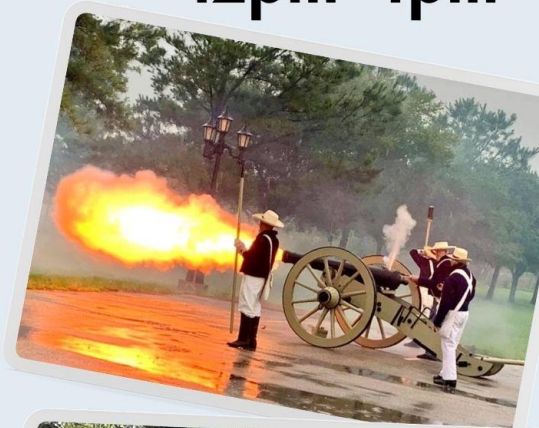
Textiles: From Field to Fabric
